APPROVAL OF AGENDA

OPEN DISCUSSION

States Attorney Bryant, Attorney Tyler Smith, Sheriff Gann, FOP Representative Jason Bryant, Union Reps Greg Cox, Jr and Greg Cox, Sr. and James Otey were all present to discuss and determine grievance interpretation of split shifts for the Mason County Sheriff's Office.

FOP Representative Bryant along with the Union members believe the language states that the Sheriff should first offer full shifts when there is a vacancy due to the termination of an employee.

Attorney Tyler Smith and Sheriff Gann argued that the Sheriff was within his right to fill the vacancy using split shifts and stated that it has been done before. They also stated that it shouldn't matter why there is a vacancy.
